Board Meeting Minutes: **Monday, January 8, 2007: 7-9 PM**

1. Norby and Linaan provided an update on the First Flight program. Snowboarding lessons are going well. Will consider going for a full season next year (have 4 lessons this year).
2. Steve Cohan report on the MSCR program plans. CASPER program for disadvantaged youth in Madison has started and will run for 8 weeks.
3. Norby reported that the jump shed is being well used and a training facility for S Wisconsin. The jump club is considering the possibility of becoming the Midwest Training Center for jumping (with a large jump, training camps, etc.)
